
Merry Christmas!

Here's how we're trying to spend this Christmas, Present.


Murrays love Christmas. It's full of worship, celebration and food. And presents. And people we love. And Facebook. And texts. Instagram.

gift to the people around




you is being fully present. Just don't be too preachy about it—people hate that kind of thing.
